The future of the Cary Towne Center has shifted dramatically as Epic Games has acquired the 87-acre site with plans to build a global headquarters campus. The Cary-based video game and software giant confirmed to TBJ it closed on the property on Thursday in a \$95 million deal with Turnbridge Equities and Denali Properties, the developers who bought the struggling mall in southeast Cary for \$31 million in early 2019 and later unveiled major plans for a massive mixed-use project. "We plan to commence development of our new headquarters this year with the goal of converting the property into our new campus by 2024," the spokesperson said. Epic Games currently has around 2,200 workers, according to data compiled by TBJ. Epic Games said the company is now working with the Town of Cary on its plans for the development, including ways to incorporate a community aspect into the project.

Construction will be completed this summer, developer Al Neyer said. The Holly Springs Town Council approved plans last week for the 20-acre development at 1317 N. Main St., north of Ting Park. The development will have office space for MyComputerCareer, apartments, retail space and a 1,000-seat performing arts theater. The corporate headquarters calls for an estimated \$24 million capital investment and \$3 million for the retail portion, said town development planner Sean Ryan at Tuesday's council meeting. The new MyComputerCareer headquarters will be in an 85,000-square-foot office building, plans show. It will replace an existing headquarters in Holly Springs. Company officials tell The News & Observer that up to 525 people will be employed at the facility, including roughly 300 existing jobs in the Triangle. MyComputerCareer, which has its flagship location in Raleigh, provides hands-on training and IT certifications at technical colleges in several other states across the country. The startup intends to use the funds to scale up and continue developing a variety of cell-based collagens and gelatins that can be used in a range of contexts, including in food, beverages, skincare and cosmetics, as well as for medical and pharmaceutical applications. "I'm thinking we'll triple that number in the next year or even sooner probably," Michelsen said. At the moment, the research and development is taking place at a lab space in the Netherlands by Hesp while Michelsen handles the business end of things in Raleigh. As Jellatech looks to raising its next round, Michelsen said the company expects to grow its presence in the Triangle region and is currently on the hunt for additional space for its growing team and operations. The company was originally partly based in the San Francisco Bay Area, where Michelsen and a handful of other biotechnology graduate students were able to travel and get an introduction to alternative proteins, such as cell-based meats and fungal-based foods. Michelsen said she was interested in working on similar endeavors, but the Bay Area proved too expensive so she decided on moving to the Triangle because it's one of the largest biotechnology hubs in the country. "It's much more affordable and it's an area that's growing a lot quickly," Michelsen said.

"Raleigh-Durham-Chapel Hill and the whole Triangle area is growing rapidly," he says. "A lot of European companies have put their U.S. headquarters here." The company employs about 20 people, five of them based in Cary. Now Yates is preparing to add product manufacturing to the Cary operation. He is searching for a suitable facility to lease, buy or build. Manufacturing will initially require three or four new employees, and more will be added later as the company ramps up and expands its production capabilities. The RTP jobs would pay an average of \$187,000 a year, according to the commerce department. The campus and engineering hub will focus on machine learning, artificial intelligence and software engineering, among others. The campus will be 1 million square feet on the Wake County side of RTP, on tracts of land straddling N.C. 540 near Cary and Morrisville. It will run on 100% renewable energy, the company said.

An open source technology firm with a growing Triangle presence just reported a \$188 million raise – capital that means jobs locally, according to the CEO. Sysdig, a container monitoring firm that now claims co-headquarters in Raleigh (it's Triangle offices are listed in Perimeter Park in Morrisville) and in San Francisco, is now valued at nearly \$1.2 billion, having raised a total funding haul of \$394 million since its inception. And it's translating to jobs in the Triangle already. Right now, the firm has about 50 employees locally. Vasudevan expects 70 to 80 percent headcount growth in the coming months, driven by the raise. “Our plan is, by the third or fourth quarter ... to expand our Raleigh footprint,” Vasudevan said, noting the firm has already looked at new space that would double the size of its current operation in the region. According to the company, the new jobs being created will be across the spectrum and include marketing, sales and engineering.
