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**Why should I participate?** This event will drive additional business to you on the day of the event.

- Your restaurant will be featured on IFC's website and social media (~1k+ followers each).
- RSVVP flyers will be shared with you and posted around town.
- RSVVP table tent cards will be delivered to you.
- 3,000+ people on IFC's listserv will be emailed several times with reminders to visit you.
- Once the event ends, you will receive a certificate of thanks to display.
- RSVVP Day has a large and loyal following that looks forward to the event.
- It's a great idea to come together for the community.
- IFC is the largest provider of social safety net services in Orange County.

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### Food Security Info:

- IFC's Community Kitchen is the only place in Orange County that serves free hot meals every day.
- IFC's Community Market is the only pantry in Orange County where shoppers select their own items Mon-Fri.
- IFC served 48,754 hot meals in FY2021-22.
- IFC distributed 532 holiday meals in November and December 2021.
- IFC's Community Market provided 11,790 bags of local produce, pantry staples, and personal hygiene items in FY2021-22.
