Home Preservation Program

About the program

Habitat for Humanity's Home Preservation Program is a locally-operated program serving low-income homeowners who struggle to maintain the interior and exterior of their homes.

Cost: If you qualify, you will be asked to pay a small portion of the repair costs using a sliding scale and payment plan.

Below is a list of repairs that qualify under this program:

- □ Exterior door repairs/replacement
- HVAC repair
- □ Roof repairs/replacement





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The application process for Home Preservation is a multi-step process. Once the application is approved, it will be about four to six months before the home repair project is completed. The amount of time required to complete the home repair project depends upon the nature of the work, weather, the number of other families who have already been approved for the program, and other related factors.

The Home Preservation Program includes "A Brush With Kindness" volunteerled repairs and contractor-led critical repairs.

The three major criteria for selection into the Home Preservation Program are:

- Need
- ☑ Willingness and ability to accept financial responsibility
- Willingness to partner with Habitat for Humanity of Orange County
