Two volunteers are needed for each shift listed above to serve with a Levee Tent Manager. Volunteers should plan to walk to the 18th hole in comfortable closed-toe shoes, a Second Harvest t-shirt (to be provided) or a white collared shirt, and khaki pants or shorts.
