Caleb Savage named “Director of Student Ministries” at Life Community Church

Ada, Okla., February 11, 2014 – Caleb Savage, a member of the Life Community Church (LCC) and a student at East Central University (ECU), has been named the “Director of Student Ministries” at the Ada-based church, according to LCC Senior Pastor Mickey Keith.

In this capacity, Savage will be responsible for student ministry programs for children and young adults from ages 10 through 18, including both Sunday and Wednesday service events. In addition, Savage will continue to lead the “The Feed” group, a program for young adult Christians he helped to organize this year at LCC.

Savage is a sophomore at ECU majoring in Political Science. A native of Del City, Oklahoma, Savage grew up in nearby Midwest City, Oklahoma, where he was a member of the Connect Church congregation.

“As our Director of Student Ministries, Caleb Savage adds a new dimension to our program and the services we offer to young members of our congregation,” Keith said. “From the time he joined our church, Caleb has demonstrated a great capacity for ‘servant leadership’ as a strong practicing Christian. As a young man, Caleb can reach the youthful in our congregation and as a Christian, he is mature beyond his years.”

Commenting on the new position and his goals for the future, Savage says he intends to provide support for both continued spiritual growth among the student members and to attract new student members to the congregation.

“Life Community Church has a strong foundation in its existing youth and student programs,” Savage said. “We will continue to focus on our existing student ministries while also building relationships with community organizations here in Ada.”

At ECU, Savage is a participant in Vision Bank’s “Presidential Leadership Program,” a member of the ECU Honors program and a member of Pi Kappa Alpha fraternity. In addition, he is a student employee in the ECU “Office of Campus Involvement.”

Life Community Church is a non-denominational Christian church founded by Senior Pastor Mickey Keith and his wife Glenda in February 2006. The Keiths have been full-time ministers since 1980. Pastor Keith is also the president of the Independent Assemblies, a national organization whose members work together in ministries, missions and fellowship programs.

LCC is currently located on 330 East 14th Street in Ada, Oklahoma. The church offers a variety of evangelical ministries to adults, young adults and children and the LCC supports Bible schools, churches and orphanages in Mexico, Philippines, Kenya, Haiti, India, Ivory Coast and Guinea-Bissau.
