Life Community Church Concludes “Families First” Series with Commitment Sunday

On Sunday, February 24, Life Community Church (LCC) in Ada concluded its Sunday segment of “Families First: Hope for Families Strong or Struggling,” series with “Commitment Sunday,” an opportunity for members of the LCC congregation to make a personal commitment in marriage, family and personal relationships.

In the final sermon in this series, Senior Pastor Mickey Keith encouraged members of the church to “Take a Stand for the Family” and to follow Biblical principles in marriage and familial relationships.

“Marriage is brutal on selfish people,” Keith said. “The more self-absorbed we become in marriage and in all personal relationships, the more we draw away from the Kingdom of God,” he said.

Noting the need for sincerity and commitment to Christian living, Keith asked the question: How long will we play at our worship, worship at our work and work at our play?

At the conclusion of the Sunday sermon, congregation members were invited to sign a “husbands and wives” or “individuals and single parents” resolution based on Biblical principles on marriage and relationships. More than 40 members of the congregation stood up and signed the “Families First Commitment.” These commitment forms are now being framed and will be returned to members on Sunday, March 3.

Members of the congregation have been enthusiastic in their support for the “Families First” series.

“It’s refreshing to hear the Word of God preached. We, as a nation, need more from the Word and not ‘feel good’ messages,” said Rhonda Moreland, a member of the LCC congregation.

“Families First” -- one of the most successful LCC series to date -- included testimony, original video productions (created by congregation members), guest appearances and interactive communications. Each week, the series focused on a specific aspect of marriage, family and

personal relationships. These included: Why the Family; Marriage on the Rock; Raising G-rated Kids in an R-rated World; His Needs, Her Needs; Dating and Waiting; and Commitment Sunday.

In addition to the Sunday program, "Families First" included the Wednesday evening "Connection" Series, concluding on February 27. This ministry has featured testimony and the video series, "Marriage on the Rock," by Jimmy Evans.
