Life Community Church to Focus on "The Wonder of the Christ" in December Services

Ada, Okla., Nov. 27, 2012 – Throughout the month of December, Life Community Church will celebrate "The Wonder of Christ" in a series of sermons by Senior Pastor Mickey Keith and Associate Pastor Curtis Reese, along with weekly activities and functions for members of the congregation and the community.

"For some, the holidays -- 'the Season of Wonder' -- are about the wonders under the Christmas tree, but there is a greater wonder that comes when we focus on the Christ in Christmas," Pastor Keith said.

"By one definition, 'wonder' is characterized as astonishment by something outside one's experience. To me, that is a fair description of the experience many of us have in the encounter with Christ. It's this sense of awe and wonder that is the theme of these sermons," Pastor Keith said.

Related to this theme, each week in December, the LCC Sunday services will host a special activity to share and express the theme of wonder.

On December 2, LCC will focus on support for the 2012 "Kingdom Kids Christmas" project, an evangelistic program sponsored by Harvest Evangelistic Association (HEA), a Christian outreach organization that provides ministry in Mexico, South America, Africa and the Philippines. The "Kingdom Kids Christmas" is annual project that reaches thousands of children, parents and ministers in hundreds of remote villages in Southern Mexico. Each year, thousands of children receive "KKC backpacks," which include school supplies, snacks, toys and Gospel information." Each backpack costs \$10, which includes the backpack, the contents and the distribution. The LCC congregation has helped support this project for the past six years and in 2011, the LCC contributed approximately \$1,500 toward this important mission. In past years, Pastor Keith participated in this project, traveling to Chiapas, Mexico as a volunteer minister. On December 9, LCC will host "Mission Sunday," a special event in which one of the international missions that LCC supports is highlighted. These events offer members of the

LCC congregation with insight into the area and culture of specific missions and how their support contributes to each mission. Life Community Church supports Bible schools, churches and orphanages in missions throughout the world. On Mission Sunday Associate Pastor Curtis Reese will present the weekly sermon, continuing the theme of "The Wonder of the Christ."

"The Not So Silent Night," the LCC Children's Christmas play, will be presented on December 16 at 6:00 p.m. at the church at 330 East 14th Street. Refreshments will be served and the community is invited to attend. The play presents a fun and wonderful perspective on the first "Silent Night," according to Pastor Glenda Keith and Children's Pastor Jeanelle Reese.

On December 23, the LCC Christmas service, "Candles, Carols and Communion," will be held at 10:00 a.m. and for this ceremony, the theme of wonder will be shared by communion, singing and special candle lighting throughout the church.
